Federal funding for housing and homeless services comes from many federal agencies. Funding for programs, including vouchers and public housing, has remained stagnant over recent years

STATE FUNDING

The state appropriations process doesn't have a housing budget. The majority of state funding is pass-through dollars from federal. Other state dollars fund Emergency Shelter Programs and other MDHHS programming

LOCAL FUNDING

Communities are increasingly relying on local funding for services, including new county and city millages, foundation dollars, and individual donations. This money can either go to the local planning bodies or directly to the agencies providing services
